## Access to personal information

Under s.362A of the *Migration Act 1958* (the Act) a review applicant, a person acting on behalf of the review applicant including their representative or any assistant under s.366A of the Act is entitled to access any written material, or a copy of any written material, given or produced to the tribunal for the purposes of the review. The entitlement is subject to statutory limitations. Written material given or produced to the tribunal usually consists of the tribunal file and department file(s).

The information held by the tribunal may include personal information, including financial and medical information, about a person or persons other than the review applicant(s). The tribunal may disclose this information to other persons for the purposes of the review within the framework created by the Act and the *Privacy Act 1988*.

If the written material contains personal information, including financial and medical information, about another person or persons (e.g. a relative or prospective employee), the review applicant, a person acting on behalf of the review applicant including their representative or any assistant under s.366A can facilitate the request by providing the tribunal with the other person or person's written consent to release their personal information. This can be done by completing this form. If the person referred to above is a child (who is not the review applicant's child), the written consent of the child's parent or legal guardian to release the child's personal information will need to be provided to the tribunal. This can be done by completing Part 2 of this form.

Completed forms can be lodged in person at the New South Wales or Victorian registries of the tribunal or at the Queensland, South Australia and Western Australia registries of the Administrative Appeals Tribunal. Completed forms can also be faxed or mailed to either the New South Wales or Victorian registries of the tribunal depending on the location of the review applicant.
